




It's an alchemic question that's very hard for us to answer: what makes a great TED talk? In this talk, which was given to a gathering of 100+

“The traditional free sample is the candy bar handout or the diapers to a new mother. The manufacturer gives away only a tiny quantity. ... A typical online site follows the 1 Percent Rule — 1 percent of users support all the rest. ... For every user who pays for the premium version, 99 others get the basic free version. The reason [Freemium] works is that the cost of serving the 99 percent is close enough to zero to call it nothing.”




